EQUESTRIAN CENTRE LAUNCHES NEW DRESSAGE COMPETITION WORTH \$1700 TO THE WINNER

Competitors taking part in North Loburn Equestrian Centre's (NLEC) summer and autumn dressage series, held at Rangiora Showgrounds, can participate in a new and exciting competition for the Woodfield Park Trophy and a top prize worth up to \$1700.

This new dressage competition, which will be held as part of the NLEC summer and autumn series is only possible because of the amazingly generous support of Woodfield Park Photography, the official NLEC event photographer. The trophy comes with the prize of a free stallion service from any one of the three warmblood stallions standing at Woodfield Park Stud.

The points based competition is open to anyone competing in NLEC's summer and autumn series, a total of six competitions held between January and June 2014 at Rangiora Showgrounds.

Points will be awarded to competitors in all classes: juniors, seniors graded and non-graded at all levels. The rider / horse partnership who has accumulated the most points over the six competitions will be declared the winner. The prize of the free stallion service is valid for 12 months from June 2014 and can be claimed by the winner, for either a mare of his or her own, or one nominated by them. To be eligible to enter competitors just need to have bought at least four official Woodfield Park photographs from any of the six qualifying competitions in each of the summer and the autumn series.

Elaine Rutherford of NLEC said; 'We are delighted with the very generous offer of support for this competition from our official photographer, Cathy Price. It promises to be very exciting and we are particularly pleased to be able to make it open to all of our competitors'.
